Ancient Greek infantry soldiers wore plate armour consisting of a cuirass, long greaves (armour for the leg below the knee), and a deep helmet—all of bronze. The Roman legionary wore a cylindrical cuirass made of four to seven horizontal hoops of steel with openings at the front and back, where they were laced together.

Instead of a breastplate, some Greeks wore body armor made of layers of stiffened linen glued together. Most of the Greeks fought wearing greaves, made of bronze, which protected their legs from just above the knee to the ankle. And they wore Corinthian helmets beaten out of a single sheet of bronze or iron.
