- Transcutaneous CO2 monitoring can help trend CO2 - Be aware of changes in lung compliance (e.g. secretions, neuromuscular blockade) - Consider suctioning +/- recruitment maneuver if O2 saturations remain low (but don't suction too much because it will de-recruit the lungs; use a closed suction system if possible)

Self-monitoring of BP refers to the regular measurement of BP by an individual at home or elsewhere outside the clinic setting.
